Basketball Beginnings Coaches Certification Level I and Level II

Basketball Beginnings is pleased to present the fall annual Coaches Clinics I and II. It is the aim of this program to develop coaches and officials in the sport of basketball for youth organizations and school boards involved in our programs.

Opportunities to coach and to officiate at school level and community levels exist for those who wish to pursue this opportunity throughout the year in camps, clinics, leagues, in-house school programs and community programs.

Coaches Clinic I

Supported by Basketball Ontario, the Coaches Clinic Level I delivers a program designed specifically for coaches of beginner and novice athletes. The program starts with a unique approach to learning how to play the game. Topic areas to be covered include: progressive skill development, skill analysis, basic team play (offense and defense), team management and the rules of basketball. Completion of the program, theory and practicum ensures Level I certification.

Coaches Clinic II

Designed for the coach of slightly more advanced and experienced teams, the Coaches Clinic II program deals with the increased technical and tactical requirements of the sport. The use of sport specific drills to enhance court awareness and sharpen skills is promoted. Topics include offensive and defensive tactics, pick and roll, rebounding and ball positioning skills, as well as game plan maneuvers, physical preparation and team development. Completion of the program following A Certification Level I requirement includes theory and practicum.

Referee Training (Fiba)

Referee Training is the third component of the Basketball Beginnings Coaches Program. Basketball is rooted in progressive fundamental skill development. Our philosophy requires the application of fundamental skills to assist in the proper execution of the game.

Referee Training is offered for those who wish to earn an income while participating in the league.

There is a fee for the referee training. The training takes place over a period of three 9 hour sessions. A handbook will be provided and an official referee shirt and whistle after completion of the training session.
